Upon purchasing any vBSkinworks product you acknowledge and agree to abide by the following:



-On breach of any of these clauses vbskinworks.com will immediately revoke your license. Furthermore, no refund will be made on license fees.


How do I install the style?

Before you make changes to your board it is always a good idea to back up your database first.

1. Extract the zip files to a folder on your computer.
2. Upload the folder "vuel" to your forums images directory (ex: forum/images/kartel/).
3. Login to your AdminCP in your vBulletin forum and click on Styles and Templates to expand the menu.
- 4 . In the expanded menu click on Download / Upload Styles, a new page will load.



5. Look for Import Style XML File on the new page. Click on browse and select the correct XML in the XML's folder that came with your download.

7. Press IMPORT to complete the skin installation.

How do I change the Logo and Forum Title?

1. The logo of the skin is located in the /vuel/misc/ folder and is named logo.gif
2. You can use the included PSD to modify the logo.

How do I install the included Fonts?

1. Extract the fonts from the zip file to the Windows Font directory
(typically located in c:/WINDOWS/FONTS/).
